Mi-T-M is proud to announce the addition of a Portable Water Reclaim system to its line of state-of-the-art water treatment equipment. The PWR Series allows wash water to be reclaimed on the job site. A 20-foot water berm is used to direct water to a vacuum head and into a holding chamber where it goes through a filtering process and sends it to a holding tank for reuse or proper disposal. Options include a wheel kit for added portability, a cyclone filter to clean wastewater to 70-microns, and a bag filter, which can filter as low as 5 microns.

Operator safety features include burst disc technology, temperature limit switch, and safety relief valve. The HD30003E2G is rated at 3000 psi and up to 3.2 gpm.
